## A SCHOOL WHICH IS ROOTED IN ITS SALESIAN TRADITION

- With a strong pastoral project which finds its source in the values of the Gospel, which suggests to follow the Christian faith, which helps the child to give his/ her life a meaning, and helps the children to pursue inward paths and to pray thanks to times of celebration.
- > In Don Bosco, teaching, educating and evangelising conjugate in a unique act.
- A support from the educative action with the implementation of sports projects (rugby, handball and tennis), arts projects, cultural projects (days on the Antiquity...).
- For the new school year 2022, classes are committed into the dynamic "Olympic classes".
- ➤ A tutelage with a group of pupils who offer their service to other pupils in many projects.
- Pupils can make the most of an education to the Relationship, of an opening onto the alterity and brotherhood, thanks to many projects and actions (partnership with the gerontological centre of St Maur, twinning with a diocese of the Central African Republic, sale of brioches, Christmas boxes...)
- A sense of celebration and joy through the feasts and celebrations.
- In a partnership with the Salesian social action: presence of the Charity Don Bosco (leisure centre which is open on Wednesdays and during school holidays)

## A SCHOOL WHICH IS COMMITTED IN THE MASTERY OF FUNDAMENTAL KNOWLEDGE

## A SCHOOL WHICH LOOKS TO THE FUTURE

- A policy to open up internationally: All the pupils from the first year of preschool (petite section) to Year 6 (CM2) study English with English speaking contributors, A school which is a member of the International Don Bosco Campus. Twinning of classes with European Salesian schools.
- Our school is involved in a European consortium Erasmus
- An English Day is organized for all the pupils in the preschool and the elementary school (an English meal is cooked at the canteen of Sévigné to celebrate this special day, the teachers do fun activities with the children on this day, such as singing English songs, playing sports that are popular in The United Kingdom...)
- An acquisition of the certification label "Eco-School" in June 2021 with projects revolving around the full development of the person and the protection of our planet, the Earth.
- ➤ Teaching methods that enable the cooperation and the mentoring (flexible classes, the Montessori pedagogy in the second year of preschool...), spaces to create, innovate and try things out and experiment.
